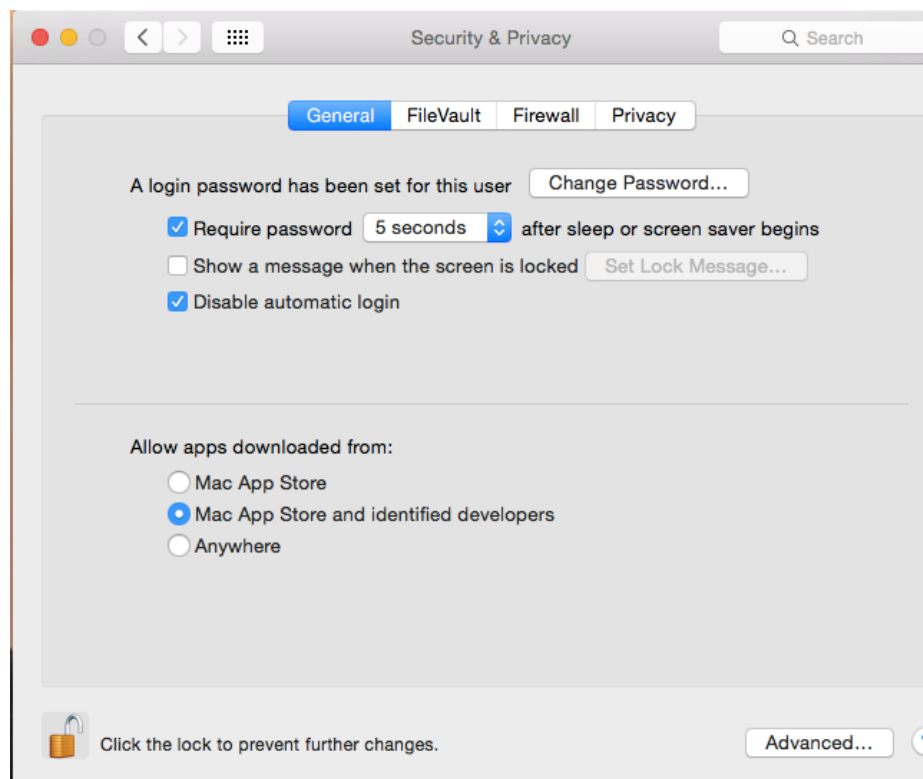
## For Windows:

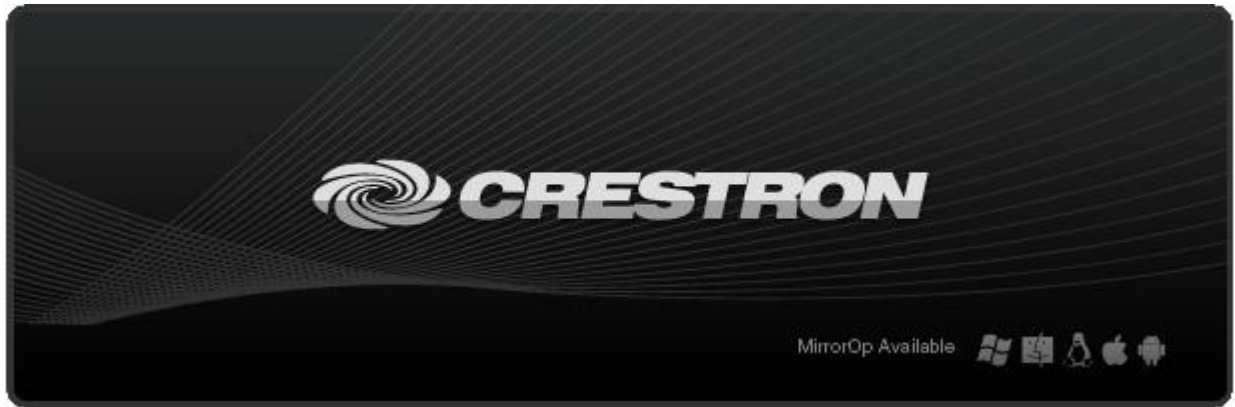
1. Once this is downloaded and installed you then will have a Creston App to be able to connect to any of the Six AirMedia Devices in the classroom.

For Mac you might have to change your settings in Security & Privacy. Allow apps downloaded from: Change this to Anywhere.

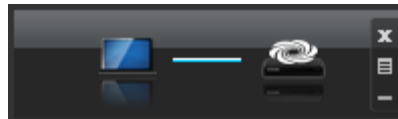


## 2. Launch the AirMedia App

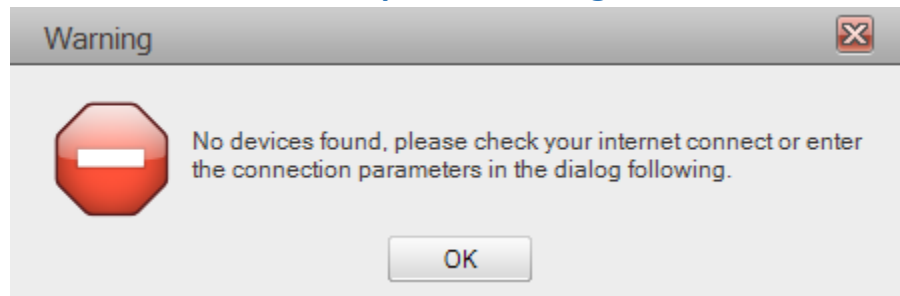
This will be the first screen you will see after launching the app
